What Does This Notice Cover?

This online Privacy Notice for the website of John Hancock Worldwide Investors, plc (<http://www.jhworldwideinvestors.com>) (the “Site” “Company”, “we”, “us”, “our”) sets out the categories of personal data we collect from you on the Site, how we collect it, what we use it for and with whom we share it in accordance with the General Data Protection Regulation (EU) 2016/679 (“GDPR”).
